


Carleton Farms Landfill Updated Information (12/2020)

1. Landfill Permits are required as of January 1, 2014. Residents can apply for a permit at the Sumpter Township Clerk's office.
2. Picture ID is required to issue a pass to the Township resident. One (1) per household and cardholder must be present at the landfill with picture ID.
3. Residential waste and proper paper bagged yard waste only; no Commercial or Industrial waste allowed.
4. All open loads **MUST** be tarped.
5. Each resident is allotted 5 yards per month-2.5 yards per punch. This includes all residential and yard waste material.
6. Residents outside of their vehicle are **REQUIRED** to wear a HIGH-VIZ vest and Hard Hat. Residents can purchase hard hat and vest at the Carleton Farms gate for \$28.00 **OR** bring their own.
7. Residents must adhere to Landfill Safety Regulations. Violators will be denied access.
8. Hours for residents to utilize the landfill:

Wednesday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Saturday from 6:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

This permit is issued only for the disposal of nonhazardous RESIDENTIAL solid waste. No commercial, industrial or non-township generated residential waste. 2. Each resident is allowed 5 yds max per month-2.5 yds per punch 3. Acceptable materials include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Household refuse/Garbage • Building and demolition debris • Trees and stumps up to 2" in diameter and less than 4' long 4. The following items are NOT acceptable: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paints, Liquids, Chemicals or Hazardous Materials, Oils of any kind. • Drums (neither full or empty), Car Batteries, Tires, Propane Tanks • Appliances that contain(ed) Freon not accepted w/o certification of removal by a certified technician as evidenced by tag affixed. 5. All loads must be tarped. 6. All vehicles must stop at the scale house and show proof of residency with picture ID and this punch card below. 7. You must stop for all landfill personnel when flagged down. 8. All loads are subject to inspection prior to acceptance. 9. All children under 12 must remain in the vehicle at all times. 10. You dump at your own risk. 11. You certify that no prohibited items are included with your load. In the event that you dispose of materials prohibited by law you will be responsible for remitting any and all fines due to as a direct result of your actions 12. If you violate the law and/or our rules/regulations at any time, your privileges will be suspended indefinitely. 13. Carleton Farms Landfill reserves the right to refuse entry at any time for any number of reasons, including but not limited to safety violations, weather conditions, non-compliance to State laws, company rules and/or policies. 14.
